PROCEEDINGS OF THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF NEPEUSKUN
HELD TUESDAY, APRIL 16, 2019.

The annual meeting of the electors of the Town of Nepeuskun was called to order at 7:05pm at the Nepeuskun Town Hall, 1475 County Road E with all Board members and 9 electors in attendance.

Clerk Pinnow certified that an official notice for this meeting had been posted at the official Town Hall posting site and Town website on April 13, 2019.

Clerk Pinnow read the minutes of the 2018 Annual Meeting. Motion was made by Sue LaBuda and second by Bob LaBuda to approve the 2018 Annual Meeting minutes as presented. 14 in favor, 0 opposed.

Chairman Bahn read the 2018 annual financial report and the Board answered questions regarding it. Motion was made by Bob LaBuda and second by Henry Stark to accept the 2018 annual financial report as presented. 14 in favor, 0 opposed.

Matters of Elector Authority as per WI Statute 60.10 – Nothing at this time.

Advisory Matters as desired by the Electors – Sue LaBuda inquired as to whether the Town Hall had a First Aid kit available. Supervisor Grahn also suggested an AED be looked into.

Bob LaBuda asked the Board about the plans for repairs to Grams Road. Chairman Bahn let electors know that the Spring Road inspection will happen on Thursday, April 18th. Many roads were severely damaged during the spring thaw. Town will have difficult decisions as what repairs to complete in 2019. Mr. LaBuda also advised that property owner on Koro Road began taking trees down on Koro Road and now felled trees are remaining in ditch blocking flow of water.

Shawn Schumacher inquired about the timing of snow removal and whether it was the best option to remove snow during the middle of the night when everything is frozen versus removing snow during the daytime when it is thawed. Chairman Bahn advised that they will discuss options during road inspection.

Jerry Trochinski inquired about setting up a committee to review and archive town records stored in the Town Hall basement.

Motion was made by Sue LaBuda and second by Bob LaBuda to adjourn. Motion carried at 8:02pm. Motion carried unanimously with 14 votes in favor, 0 opposed.
