PROCEEDINGS OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE NEPEUSKUN TOWN BOARD HELD  
MONDAY, MAY 18, 2015.

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Nepeuskun was called to order at 7:01pm at the Nepeuskun Town Hall; 1475 County Road E with all board members, Zoning Administrator Trochinski absent and 5 citizens present for the meeting.

Clerk Pinnow certified that an official notice for this meeting had been posted at the three official posting sites within the Town on May 16, 2015.

Motion was made by Supervisor Heise and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve the agenda for the May 18, 2015 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Rush Lake Project:

Chairman Bahn is monitoring water level at the dam. He is keeping the level a bit higher than normal in anticipation of dryer weather.

Ripon Fire District:

Supervisor Wargula reported on the last meeting. Elections were held and all members stayed the same with the exception of the appointment of Chairman Bahn. The District will be reviewing the Town of Nepeuskun share of annual costs for the RAFD. Chairman Bahn had a discussion with the RAFD fire chief to discuss the potential of a future full-time fire department consolidation with other area towns. This would help reduce the cost of duplicated vehicles and equipment and having a full time fire department could also reduce response times.

Clausen Pit Truck Traffic:

Brush Cutting/Chipping/Ditch Mowing/Snowplowing Report:

Supervisor Heise reported that spring brush work is complete.
