PROCEEDINGS OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE NEPEUSKUN TOWN BOARD HELD MONDAY, JULY 18, 2016.

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Nepeuskun was called to order at 7:09pm at the Nepeuskun Town Hall; 1475 County Road E with Supervisor Wargula absent, Zoning Administrator Trochinski and 6 citizens present for the meeting.

Clerk Pinnow certified that an official notice for this meeting had been posted at the official Town Hall posting site and the Town Website on July 16, 2016.

Motion was made by Supervisor Heise and second by Chairman Bahn to approve the agenda for the July 18, 2016 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

County Sheriff's Deputy Report:

Motion was made by Supervisor Heise and second by Chairman Bahn to approve the minutes of the June 20, 2016 Regular Monthly Town Board Meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Zoning Administrators Report:

Zoning Administrator Trochinski is planning to follow-up with John Schuster regarding culvert/driveway permit request.

Mary Blackburn Langberg has contacted Town regarding placing non-contaminated soil on A-2 land. Legal counsel was contacted and we are following his recommendation. Land owner will need to provide erosion control permit from Winnebago County, approval of county zoning if placed in shore land, and a signed letter from the owner of the source of the soil and the landowner that no contaminants are contained in the soil. There are limited controls for the town when soil is placed in A-2.

Discussion was held regarding Municipal Code Chapter 15 – Fire Protection and Burning Ordinance #2013-002. Chairman Bahn has been in contact with Town Attorney who is waiting for a response from RAFD president Joel Brockman. Nothing new to report as Supervisor Wargula was absent from meeting.

Motion was made by Supervisor Heise and second by Chairman Bahn to approve of LD 02-16 for Jacob Krause (parcels 0140116, 0140120) pending signatures of both parties. Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion was held regarding recently received 2016 ditch mowing contract with Ripon Truck and completed ditch mowing work. Motion was made by Supervisor Heise and second by Chairman Bahn to approve the 2016 Ditch Mowing Contract with Ripon Truck. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of Bills and Vouchers:
