PROCEEDINGS OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE NEPEUSKUN TOWN BOARD HELD
MONDAY, DECEMBER 18, 2017.

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Nepeuskun was called to order at 7:03pm at the Nepeuskun Town Hall; with all Board Members, Zoning Administrator Trochinski and 8 citizens present for the meeting.

Clerk Pinnow certified that an official notice for this meeting had been posted at the official Town Hall posting site and the Town Website on December 16, 2017.

Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Grahn to approve the agenda for the December 18, 2017 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

County Sheriff's Deputy Report:
No one present for the meeting.

Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Grahn to approve the minutes of the November 20, 2017 Regular Monthly Board Meeting with one correction. Motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer's report for December 18, 2017: Township Account, \$93,535.55 Fire & Ambulance Equipment Account, \$50,307.46. Motion made by Supervisor Grahn and second by Chairman Bahn to approve the Treasurer's Reports for December 18, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

Public Appearances:

Bob and Sue LaBuda inquired as to weight limits on Koro Road. Recent truck traffic has been hauling extremely heavy loads. Chairman Bahn will reach out to individuals to see if there is an alternate route they may be able to use to limit damage to town roads.

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Action Appraisers has requested the 2017 zoning permits issued by the Town. New Business:

Motion was made by Chairman Bahn and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve the transfer of \$15,000 from Town fund to Fire and Ambulance Equipment Fund. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Chairman Bahn to appoint 2018-2019 election workers to include Bob and Sue LaBuda, Barb and Jerry Trochinski, Tom and Wendy Stobbe, Mervin Brunette, Henry Stark and Les Achterberg. Motion carried unanimously.

Agenda Item D was moved up on the agenda due to the attendance of Art Rathjen, Director of Strategic Initiatives for Greater Oshkosh Economic Development Corporation. Mr. Rathjen provided an overview of approved and current projects within Winnebago County. Motion was made by Supervisor Grahn and second by Supervisor Wargula to allocate Nepeuskun per capita funding (\$820.00) from Winnebago County Industrial Development Board to Greater Oshkosh Economic Development Corp (GO-EDC). Motion carried unanimously.

Discussion was held regarding ATV/UTV route using Town roads. Chairman Bahn reached out to WTA for guidance. They advised that there is nothing related to state statutes that bounds the town to take action and is fully at the discretion of the town board. Chairman Bahn also reached out to the Winnebago County Highway Commissioner who is adamantly opposed to utilizing County roads as ATV/UTV routes. Numerous concerns were brought up by residents and discussed. At this time, the Board will wait to see how neighboring towns proceed before continuing process due to inability to connect with routes outside of the town.

Clerk Pinnow will submit registrations for WI Towns Association District meeting scheduled Friday, February 9, 2018 to be held at Royal Ridges in Ripon.

Approval of Bills and Vouchers:

Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Grahn to approve check numbers 8556-8578 in the amount of \$48,290.20. Motion carried unanimously.
