PROCEEDINGS OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE NEPEUSKUN TOWN BOARD HELD MONDAY, JUNE 19, 2017.

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Nepeuskun was called to order at 7:03pm at the Nepeuskun Town Hall; with Clerk Pinnow and Zoning Administrator Trochinski absent and 10 citizens present for the meeting.

Chairman Bahn certified that an official notice for this meeting had been posted at the official Town Hall posting site and the Town Website on June 17, 2017.

Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Grahn to approve the agenda for the June 19, 2017 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

County Sheriff's Deputy Report:

Sheriff's Deputy Kyle Beck was present for the meeting. He had nothing new to report.

Motion was made by Chairman Bahn and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve the minutes of the May 15, 2017 Regular Monthly Board Meeting with one correction. Motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer's report for June 19, 2017: Township Account, \$119,056.31, Fire & Ambulance Equipment Account, \$50,282.24. Motion made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Grahn to approve the Treasurer's Reports for June 19, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

Public Appearances:

Lindy Luker read a prepared statement and asked that the Board look into the possibility of utilizing a shared calendar for Town Hall activities.

Zoning Administrators Report:

No report received for the month.

Board received recommendation from Plan Commission for CUP #03-17 and LD #02-17

Old Business:

Nothing for the month.

New Business:

Motion was made by Chairman Bahn and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve CUP #03-17 for Chan and Ka Vang with the addition to the recommendation #7 All Federal, State, and County regulations regarding livestock must be met. Motion carried with Bahn and Wargula in favor and Grahn opposed.

Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Grahn to approve of LD #02-17 for Royal Vista Holstein, LLC tax parcel #014028302. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Supervisor Grahn and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve renewal of Class B retail alcohol license for Arnie's 2 LLC. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Chairman Bahn and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve renewal of Class B retail alcohol license for Vines and Rushes. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Supervisor Grahn and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve of three bartenders licenses for the Log Cabin Bar & Grill. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Chairman Bahn and second by Supervisor Wargula to renew Conditional Use Permit #04-12 for Donald Wagner until August 1, 2017 and also with the request that Don Wagner or representative be present for the July Regular Monthly Town Board meeting to discuss longer term renewal. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Chairman Bahn and second by Supervisor Grahn to approve of cleaning services at the Town Hall by Patty's (Miller) Custom Cleaning. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of Bills and Vouchers:

Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Chairman Bahn to approve check numbers 8465-8487 including the EFTPS payment in the amount of \$20,474.65. Motion carried unanimously.

Reports from Board Members

Rush Lake Project:

Water level on lake has fluctuated quite a bit with recent rains. Bogs currently collecting by the dam which will need to be cleaned out when the water level goes down.

Ripon Fire District:

Meeting was held on June 6, 2017. Special meeting will be held on June 26, 2017 to review the audit. August meeting will include review of past due payments owed to fire district. RAFD is part of a strike team that enabled a local team to be dispatched to assist with the Cambria explosion. Year to date - 108 fire calls, an increase from the same time last year.

Berlin Fire Department:

Nothing to report.

Clausen Pit Truck Traffic:

Nothing received for the month.

Brush Cutting/Chipping/Ditch Mowing/Snowplowing Report:

Shawn Schumacher is no longer interested in providing brush cutting services and Jim Heise is no longer coordinating service. Chairman Bahn has contacted Winnebago County to provide the service.

Town Website Committee Report:

Currently there are 17 email sign-ups.

Farmland Preservation:

Nearing the end of the sign-up period. Chairman Bahn has been reaching out to landowners to make sure those that are interested are signed up. Winnebago County is making Farmland Preservation voluntary. Hopefully will be ready and reviewed by the County Board in October to then be approved by the State.
