Ripon Fire District:

Ripon Public Library is doing a fundraising drive to purchase a drone for the fire department. The cost of the drone is \$12,000. RAFD and Ripon Police Department will assist with the purchase.

Three fire fighters received their training certificates for the diving and rescue team. RAFD received a third container that can be used for their new training tower which will allow them to meet state certification requirements.

Berlin Fire Department:

Currently have 30 fire fighters. Two additional vehicles were purchased from the DNR to assist with brush fires. Berlin does not have any big truck purchases in sight for another 8 years.

Clausen Pit Truck Traffic: Nothing received for the month.

Brush Cutting/Chipping/Ditch Mowing/Snowplowing Report:

Chairman Bahn reached out to RTC to give them the go ahead to start ditch mowing when they are available.
