PROCEEDINGS OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE NEPEUSKUN TOWN BOARD HELD MONDAY, DECEMBER 16, 2019.

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Nepeuskun was called to order at 7:02pm at the Nepeuskun Town Hall; with all Board members and 16 citizens present for the meeting.

Clerk Pinnow certified that an official notice for this meeting had been posted at the official Town Hall posting site and the Town Website on December 13, 2019.

Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Zache to approve the agenda for the December 16, 2019 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

County Sheriff's Deputy Report:

Deputy Wuest was present for the meeting. He inquired as to whether town residents had any questions for him or areas of concern.

Motion was made by Supervisor Zache and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve the minutes of the November 18, 2019 Regular Monthly Board meeting as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Zache to approve the minutes of the October 21, 2019 Budget Hearing and Special Meeting of Town Electors. Motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer's report for December 16, 2019: Township Account, \$79,372.55, Fire & Ambulance Equipment Account, \$69,563.42. Motion made by Supervisor Zache and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve the Treasurer's Report for December 16, 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

Public Appearances:

Brett Helmbrecht provided comment related to recently posted no trespassing signs on Island Rd property owned by the Town of Nepeuskun. Chairman Grahn inquired as to whether Mr. Helmbrecht would be willing to provide a copy of his comments and provide the Board an opportunity to review and place on the January Regular Monthly Meeting Agenda.

Zoning Administrators Report:

December 2019

Year End Report was distributed.

Home subject to potential junk/nuisance violation at 1870 Harris Rd has been demolished. Town Constable will post No Trespassing signs on the park and road extension near Island Rd. Zoning Administrator Trochinski extended a thank you to local businesses and residents that submitted letters of support for the transportation aid grant application.

Old Business:

Nothing new to report at this time regarding pick up of overflow recycling after recycling dates.

13c. Motion was made by Supervisor Zache and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve of transfer of \$15,000 from Town fund to Fire and Ambulance Equipment fund. Motion carried unanimously.

13d. Motion was made by Supervisor Zache and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve of Local Government Investment Pool (LGIP) Resolution. Motion carried unanimously.

13e. Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Zache to approve of the appointment of Ronald Bahn as town representative to the RLWRI Board. Motion carried unanimously.

13f. Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Chairman Bahn to appoint 2020-2021 election workers to include Bob and Sue LaBuda, Barb and Jerry Trochinski, Tom and Wendy Stobbe, Mervin Brunette, Henry Stark, Teresa Saylor, Les Achterberg and Olivia Herrick. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of Bills and Vouchers:

Motion was made by Supervisor Zache and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve check numbers 9008-9034 in the amount of \$47,500.91 including the EFTPS payment in the amount of \$1,493.28. Motion carried unanimously.

Rush Lake Project:

Brett Helmbrecht provided update. 2020 Lake Management Planning grant was submitted a week ago.

Ripon Fire District:

Meeting held on December 3, 2019. Service awards for retired fire fighters was reviewed. Barry Vandebink was named acting president for the district as the current president needed to resign as he is moving out of the district. Discussion was held regarding budgeting for capital expenses and the need for more notice to be provided to RAFD members.

Brush Cutting/Chipping/Ditch Mowing/Snowplowing Report:

Chairman Grahn provided an update of snowplowing damage reports from local residents. He has contacted Ripon Truck and Mr. Lieske indicated he would look at damage done. Most recent contract indicates Ripon Truck is not responsible for any damage done by plow trucks.
