MONDAY, MARCH 18, 2019.

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Nepeuskun was called to order at 7:05pm at the Nepeuskun Town Hall; with Clerk Pinnow absent, Zoning Administrator Trochinski and 9 citizens present for the meeting.

Chairman Bahn certified that an official notice for this meeting had been posted at the official Town Hall posting site and the Town Website on March 14, 2019.

Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Grahn to approve the agenda for the March 18, 2019 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

#### Old Business:

#### New Business:

Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Grahn to approve of LD #01-19 for Ronald/Donald Wagner – tax parcel #0140256. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Chairman Bahn and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve the renewal of Conditional Use Permit #03-17 for Chan and Ka Vang. Motion carried with Bahn and Wargula in favor and Grahn opposed (due to the CUP not being in line with the future use plan).

Motion was made by Chairman Bahn and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve of a new furnace at the Town Hall. Advantage Inc will install a single stage #3157 Honeywell furnace with a minimum of 115,000 TU spec with a programmable thermostat not to exceed \$263. Supervisor Grahn will research Focus on Energy rebates. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made to Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Grahn to approve of Nepeuskun News Vol. 19, Issue 1 – March 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of Bills and Vouchers:

Motion was made by Supervisor Grahn and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve check numbers 8852- 8870 including EFTPS in the amount of \$65,143.06. Motion carried unanimously.
