

# Town of Nepeuskun

PROCEEDINGS OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE NEPEUSKUN TOWN BOARD HELD MONDAY, FEBRUARY 17, 2020.

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Nepeuskun was called to order at 7:00pm at the Nepeuskun Town Hall; with all Board members and 8 citizens present for the meeting.

Clerk Pinnow certified that an official notice for this meeting had been posted at the official Town Hall posting site and the Town Website on February 14, 2020.

Motion was made by Supervisor Zache and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve the agenda for the February 17, 2020 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Zache to approve the Consent Agenda for the February 17, 2020 meeting including the minutes for the January 20, 2020 meeting, Treasurer's Report and Bills and Vouchers 9060-9076 in the amount of \$321,223.70. Motion carried unanimously.

Old Business:

9a. Review of recycling overflow concerns will be discussed in item 10e in new business.

9b. Nothing new to report on 625 and 627 County Road E activity. Item can be removed from the agenda until a future meeting date.

New Business:

10a. Motion was made by Supervisor Zache and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve LD 01-20 for Scott & Kasi Ludwig, tax parcel # 014006802. Motion carried unanimously.

10b. Discussion was held regarding purchase of digital recording devices(s). Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Zache to approve the purchase of two digital recording devices not to exceed \$200 and report back at a future meeting.

10c. Discussion was held regarding internet access for Town Hall (equipment and monthly fee). Motion was made by Supervisor Zache and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve the DH Wireless Solutions equipment purchase and Verizon Wireless monthly fee for internet service. Motion carried unanimously.

10d. Motion was made by Supervisor Zache and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve the cancellation of the town hall land line with CenturyLink. Motion carried unanimously.

10e. Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Zache to approve of 2020 recycling overflow and litter pickup rates for John Schure not to exceed \$35/hr plus fees. Motion carried unanimously.

10f/g. Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Zache to approve of the Open Book date of May 18, 2020 from 11am to 1pm and Board of Review date of May 27, 2020 from 4pm to 6pm. Motion carried unanimously.

10h. Discussion was held regarding ATV/UTV Route ordinance. Chairman Grahn requested Mr. Yancy bring a proposed route map of town roads that would connect to other neighboring town trails versus the previous all town road recommendation.

10i. Discussion was held on hunting on township owned parcels. Chairman Grahn will contact Town Attorney to obtain more information as it relates to the law and parcels in question.

#### Reports from Board Members

##### Rush Lake Project:

Brett Helmbrecht provided update. Phase 2 Lake Management planning grant will be awarded in the amount of \$25,000. Lake Management Plan Rollout Event @ Vines and Rushes on October 19, 2020. Water level planning was discussed and requested feedback from the Town of Nepeuskun. Bob LaBuda has resigned from his RLWRI board seat. His three year term is set to expire in January 2021. Brett inquired as to whether Town would like him to contact the list of 14 individuals who expressed interest in the 2019 survey.

##### Ripon Fire District:

Meeting held on February 4, 2020. Replacement boiler has been discussed but not voted upon. Cost for replacement would be an expense split amongst the fire district members. Cost to Nepeuskun should be approximately \$600.

##### Berlin EMS/Fire Department:

2019 Berlin Fire Department Annual Report received. Town of Nepeuskun had 1 fire call and 2 accident calls throughout 2019.

##### Snowplowing Report:

Complaints and concerns continue to come in regarding snow plowing work completed.

##### Town Website Committee Report:

Nothing new to report.

##### Farmland Preservation:

Update provided by Ron Bahn. Waiting on state certification.

##### Correspondence:

- Highway Commissioner as indicated their plan to get Town road work completed early in the season. May prohibit additional work being completed later in the season.
- Bill Johnson, sent letter to Supervisor Wargula inquiring about AED sale and service. Supervisor Wargula will respond to let him know that the town has already purchased an AED and a town resident is providing free training.

Motion was made by Supervisor Zache and second by Supervisor Wargula to adjourn. Motion carried at 8:42pm. Motion carried unanimously.
