PROCEEDINGS OF THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE NEPEUSKUN TOWN BOARD HELD MONDAY, JUNE 15, 2020.

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Nepeuskun was called to order at 7:05pm at the Nepeuskun Town Hall, 1475 County Rd E., with all Board members and 3 citizens present for the meeting.

Clerk Pinnow certified that an official notice for this meeting had been posted at the official Town Hall posting site and the Town Website on June 12, 2020.

Motion was made by Supervisor Zache and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve the agenda for the June 15, 2020 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Zache to approve the Consent Agenda for the June 15, 2020 meeting including:

Reports from Board Members

Rush Lake Project:

Brett Helmbrecht provided update. South boat landing has been extremely busy. DNR is working on removing bogs. East landing has been clear all season.

Next meeting to be held in July to discuss what is next for Rush Lake Watershed Restoration Inc.

Brush Cutting Report:

Brush cutting crew has been extremely busy with clean up after recent storm. Clean up continues as chipper and crew is available.

Ripon Fire District:

Elections were held. Barry Vandebriuk was elected as new president. Supervisor Wargula was elected as vice president. Jim Werch retains the treasurer/secretary position. New boiler was installed at the fire house on June 3rd.

Berlin EMS/Fire Department:

Nothing received for the month.

Farmland Preservation:

Plan Commission is working to get the new ordinance as it relates to Farmland Preservation certified by the end of the year so qualified farmers would qualify for tax credit.

Correspondence:

- Chairman Grahn is working with Ripon Truck to ensure they don't mow ditches in front of the Butzin property.
- Town Attorney advised Town to not sign acceptance paperwork for Koro Road grant project until pending court case has been resolved. Senator Feyen will look into what the existing court case is and follow up with Town.
