## **Town of Nepeuskun**

PROCEEDINGS OF THE SPECIAL BOARD MEETING OF THE TOWN OF NEPEUSKUN HELD MONDAY, MAY 1, 2017.

The special board meeting of the Town of Nepeuskun was called to order at 8:55pm at the Nepeuskun Town Hall, 1475 County Road E with all Board members and 9 citizens present.

Clerk Pinnow certified that an official notice for this meeting had been posted at the official Town Hall posting site and Town website on April 29, 2017.

Public Appearances: Nothing at this time.

Discussion was held with Ken Jaworski and Jerry Trochinski regarding possible revisions necessary to Municipal Code 11. The process to request a Special Use Permit was reviewed. It was determined that Mr. Prellwitz did not meet the thirty day application date, however, the Board agreed it would still consider the request but wanted to note that this would not set a precedence for other individuals applying without following proper procedure.

Supervisor Grahn wanted to make Board aware that he is a member of the Ripon Rotary (event sponsor) but noted he is not acting as a volunteer for the event.

Motion was made by Chairman Bahn and second by Supervisor Wargula to approve of Special Use (Special Event) Permit #01-17 for Ryan Prellwitz, 410 County Rd E, Ripon, WI – running event to be held May 6, 2017 from 9am – 12pm. Motion amended by Chairman Bahn to include traffic control at County Road E, Koro, Lake, Meadowbrook and Grams Road as well as the notification of the Town of Berlin to provide traffic control at Willard Road crossing. Certificate of Liability Insurance also needs to be amended to include the Town of Nepeuskun. Motion to approve with amendment was carried with 3 votes in favor and 0 opposed. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Supervisor Wargula and second by Supervisor Grahn to adjourn. Motion carried at 9:27pm. Motion carried unanimously.
