PROCEEDINGS OF THE NEPEUSKUN TOWN PLAN COMMISSION MEETING HELD ON MONDAY, MAY 7, 2018, AT 6:30PM AT THE TOWN HALL, 1475 COUNTY ROAD E.

Chairman Sillanpaa called the meeting of the Nepeuskun Town Plan Commission to order at 6:30pm at the Nepeuskun Town Hall. Other members present; Lindy Luker, Michelle LaPorte, Dennis Miller and Kyle Grahn. Karen Bartels and Paul Resop excused. Several members from the community were also present.

Secretary LaPorte certified that official notice of the meeting was posted on Saturday, May 5, 2018.

Lindy Luker moved to approve the Agenda as printed. Second by Dennis Miller. Motion carried unanimously.

Dennis Miller moved to approve the April 2, 2018, Regular Monthly Meeting Minutes as read and printed. Second by Lindy Luker. Motion carried unanimously.

Public Participation: Ken Jaworski and Henry Stark.

Report on Town Board Action: Kyle Grahn reported approval of Conditional Use Permit #03-12 for Wayne Kauffman and Special Events Permit #01-18 for Ryan and Charles Prellwitz. There was also approval of Resolution #04162018 for the Public Participation Plan for the Comprehensive Plan Update. There were also several Plan Commission member reappointments.

Ken Jaworski reviewed and updated the Existing Land Use Map along with several other maps in the Town Comprehensive Plan with members. Chairman Sillanpaa moved to approve recommendation to conduct a Farmland Preservation Analysis based on the following criteria: 1) 10 acres or more of tillable land 2) Set Federal and State Land 3) All land zoned A-1 and A-2. Second by Dennis Miller. Motion carried unanimously.

Future Agenda Items: Review and discussion with Ken Jaworski on Analysis Maps for Farmland Preservation and Comprehensive Plan Land Use Maps.
